***Bryan's House** submitted its proposal to update the playground equipment and add a brand new canopy for shade during the hot summer months.

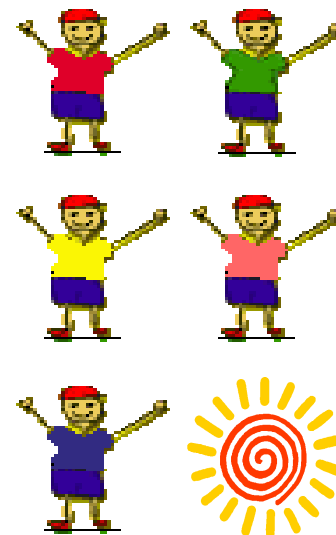
***Cancer Support Community's** proposal was for a Noogieland sponsor to support its 2017 programs benefiting children and teens.
